

Searching the Internet with Internet Explorer

- Searching the Internet can be very useful for finding new links to other pages that may be of interest to a person visiting your site.
- You can perform searches using keywords about the topic you wish to search for.
- Open *Internet Explorer* and click on the *Search* button.
- You are using you should see a search page or a search pane open on the left, depending on which version of *Internet Explorer*.
- Either way, you will see a text box for you to enter your search criteria.
- You should also see a *help* link or *search tips*. It is always a good idea to study this information to help you perform your searches.
- If you neglect this valuable resource there is a very good chance you will either not find the information or find so many links that you wouldn't have enough time to investigate them all. So, make sure to get familiar with the search engine you use.
- There are different companies that have search engines, (Excite, Yahoo, InfoSeek, Web Crawler, ...) each one may have their own search format.
- The ability to search the web and link to a plethora of information is a key element in what makes the Internet so powerful.
