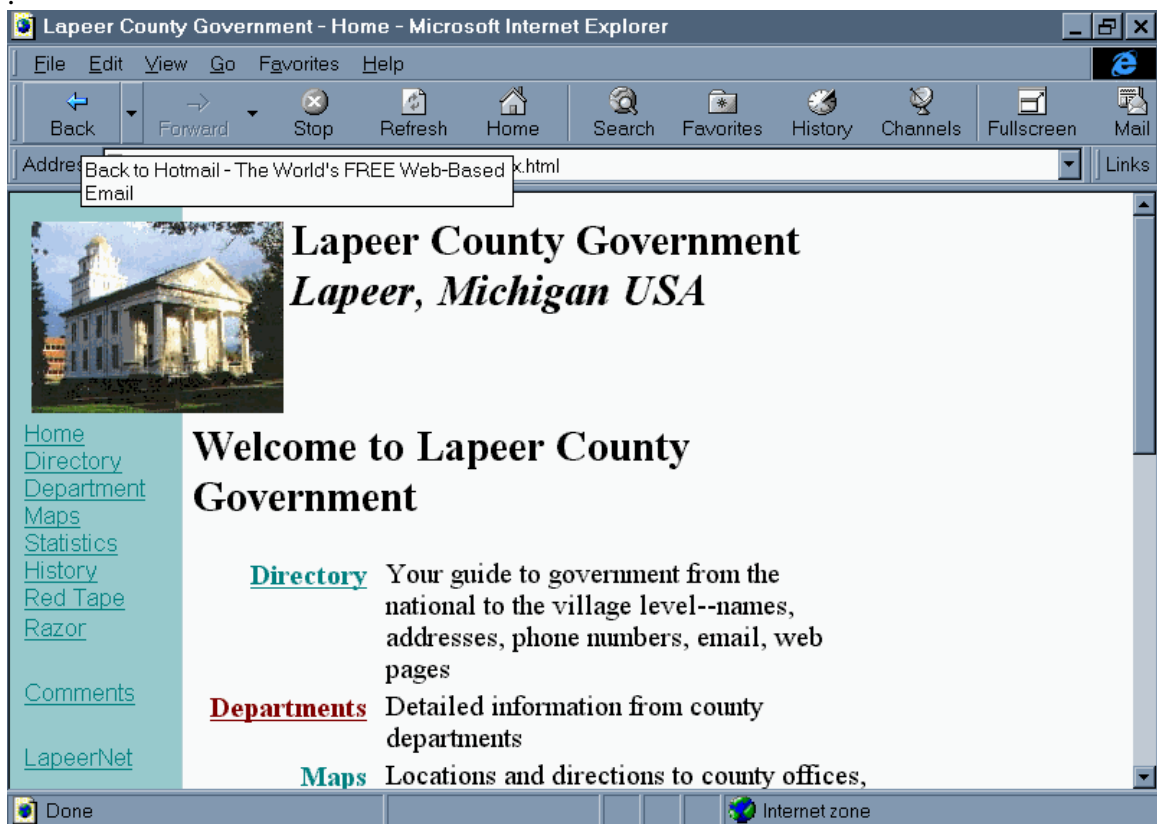


Exploring the Internet with Internet Explorer(IE)

- When you are in *IE* you can also browse the *Internet/World Wide Web*. (for the most part, these two terms are interchangeable)
- If you have the address for a page you can type it in the *Address* box at the top of the *IE* window.
- You can type the address with or without the `http://` prefix. (e.g. both the following addresses will work. <http://www.lapeer.lib.mi.us/Index.html> or <www.lapeer.lib.mi.us/Index.html>)
- You can navigate forward and backward through the pages that you visited during your session with *IE* by using the *Back* and *Forward* buttons in the upper left corner
